Directions: From the South, leave the M4 at junction 32, take A470 signposted to Merthyr Tydfil. Follow A470 6 miles (approx), pass service station on left hand side. **Follow step 2.**

From the North, come down M50 onto the M4 coming off at junction 32. Turn right onto the A4059 and **Follow step 2.**

Step 2: At roundabout of M4, turn left onto the A4059 for 3.5miles until you enter Mountain Ash. Turn left at Troed-y-rhiw Rd and turn left again to join Cardiff Road. The Pub will be on your left hand side. The Country Park is the other side of the road over a footbridge.



The overall area of the site is indicated in green above. **The car park is indicated with a red star above.**

From the car park head northwest on Cardiff Rd towards Troed-y-rhiw Rd, turn right at Troed-y-rhiw Rd.

Turn left at A4059/New Rd, go through 1st set on traffic lights, 100yrd's further on, turn right. (When you turn right the Bowls Club will be on your left hand side)

Turn right toward Dyffryn Rd, stay on this road. At the mini roundabout turn left signposted CefnPennar, follow road through woods, up hill, over single track bridge, taking the 3rd turning on left into Mountain Ash Golf Club. There is a sign on the corner of drive.
