

Rudry Common Car Park

This contract involved the construction of stone-faced feature retaining walls within an existing stone surfaced car park together with the construction of a footpath to improve disabled access.



Existing earth bunding was reduced and reshaped. Retaining walls were constructed comprising a blockwork inner skin set off new concrete foundations. The blockwork was then faced with pennant sandstone.

A drystone walling finish was required so the walling was part mortared and tied into the blockwork with galvanized wall ties.



A new footpath was created leading to the carpark, edged in timber with a gravel finish.

14no. stone monoliths were erected at various locations around the site. These were pennant sandstone.

The carpark was regraded and topped with suitable stone ready for tarmacing.

Newly topsoiled areas were cultivated and seeded.
